

AUGUST LEGACY FUNDS DRIVE

The nature of this mission field is that the numbers of those incarcerated in Texas have not diminish during hard economic times. This ministry continues to be blessed because you coming alongside financially to help us take the gospel of Jesus to those in county, state, and federal imprisonment. In three different facilities no less than 24 souls were added to Christ in the last two weeks alone. That is happening because of your prayers and support!



August is our annual legacy funds drive. We have two legacy accounts, the Rachel N. Kolb account increased by \$1,105 in August and the Buck & Janet Griffith account saw an increase of \$5,125 in August. These legacy accounts will give an assurance that the work in this mission field continues during times when the economy hits all of us hard. I wrote in the August newsletter that it is less important who plants or who waters, but the increase in the Kingdom is what matters. Your prayers, your financial partnership, our hands and feet- all of these combined are planting the seed of God's word in hearts and watering that seed to produce a harvest for our Lord.
